

“Back to School Immunizations”

The Warren County Health Department would like to remind all parents to schedule their children’s back-to-school immunizations. The schedule fills up quickly in August so call early to schedule an appointment. To help busy parents – who can’t get off work to bring their children into the office, the department offers a “Parent Consent Authorization Form” found at www.warrencountyhealth.org.

Immunizations are available by appointment only. You should bring your child’s immunization records when you come for your appointment. If you have lost or misplaced your child’s records we suggest you contact your child’s physician or obtain a copy of their school medical records. A complete list of vaccination requirements is available online at www.warrencountyhealth.com

Families with health insurance are encouraged to obtain necessary vaccinations from their private health care provider; however, no child is turned away. For those with private insurance we ask for a donation equal to your co-pay for an office visit, for the uninsured we also ask for a donation. For children on the Medicaid or MC+ program there is no charge for immunizations.

Immunizations play an important role in preventable disease. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services coordinates services with public and private health care providers to immunize all of Missouri citizens.
